Papers Submission

Contributed Papers

Prospective authors of technical contributed papers are asked to submit up to 6 pages on double column IEEE format (www.ieee.org) and follow the IEEE PDF Requirements for creating PDF documents for the IEEE Xplore. Both word and PDF files are needed for submission. For detailed format information, please visit the conference website.

Final manuscripts exceeding six pages and up to 8 pages will be subjected to publication extra page charges of LE 50/US\$ 50 per page. Submitted papers will be refereed by peer reviewers to ensure the quality of the technical content. Papers to be presented at MEPCON'10 must contain original material.

At least one of the prospective authors of each paper must register in the conference. For each additional paper, 50% of the registration fees are required. Each paper must be presented by one of the authors in order to be published in the conference proceedings. All papers will then be reviewed again after the conference for possible publication in MEPCON 2010 Journal.

Organized Sessions

Organized sessions will be arranged. Interested participants are invited to send their ideas for organized sessions to the Conference Chairman.

Tutorials, Round Tables Discussions & Workshops
